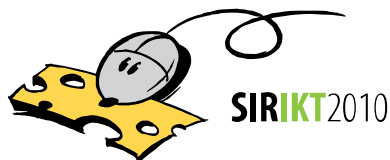

Povzetek

iEARN Slovenija ima vedno več aktivnih članic in članov. International Educational And Resource Network je velika mednarodna organizacija učencev, dijakov, staršev in učiteljev, ki sodelujejo v mednarodnih projektih iz vseh področji šole in življenja. Vsem udeležencem ponuja različne spletne dejavnosti, ki popestrijo pouk in učenje izven šolskega časa. Učitelju omogoča, da visoko motivira učence in dijake za pridobivanje znanja in aktivno sodelovanje pri različnih projektih, kot so ekološke, humanitarne, kulturne in družbene akcije. Učenci in dijaki razvijajo komunikacijske spretnosti v več jezikih, spoznavajo druge kulture in življenje v različnih razmerah. Razvijajo toleranco in interkulturalno kompetenco.



Učitelji imajo vrsto možnosti spletnih izobraževanj in enkrat letno možnost udeležbe na konferenci iEARN, ki se vsako leto organizira v drugi državi.

Predstavljeni bodo različni zanimivi projekti, ki smo jih učitelji že preizkusili s slovenskimi učenci in dijaki. Na domači spletni strani so gradiva, ki učiteljem olajšajo načrtovanje, izvedbo in zaključek projekta.

V sodelovanju z iEARN je v Sloveniji postal aktiven tudi nov projekt imenovan GTP – Global Teenager Project, ki različnim starostnim skupinam omogoča sodelovanje na različnih področjih: pravljice, legende, družina, zdravje, prosti čas, zgodovina, geografija, etika itd. On-line sodelovanje temelji na spletni komunikaciji v obsegu 10 tednov, dvakrat letno.

Predstavili bomo primere dobre prakse iz letošnjega šolskega leta, ko so se tri skupine vključile v »učni krog« 10 do 12 skupin s celega sveta ter raziskovali različna področja.

Abstract

iEarn Slovenia is becoming very active educational and resource network in Slovenia, being a part of wider international network, which connects students, parents and teachers from all over the world. International projects offer different topics and themes for school work as well as for after school activities. Students are highly motivated for learning, discovering and researching. They take an active part in different projects like ecological, humanitarian, cultural actions. They learn how to use ICT properly, learn to communicate in different languages and become aware about different countries, lives and circumstances. They develop tolerance and intercultural competences.

Teachers have several options to take part in on-line courses and to meet at annual conferences which are held all over the world.

We will present several interesting projects going on in Slovenia and offer materials for easier start of project work.

In cooperation with international iEarn there is a project called GTP-Global Teenager Project run by IICD from the Netherlands. The **Global Teenager Project (GTP)**, initiated and co-funded by **IICD**, offers thematic [Learning Circles](#) to Elementary, Secondary and Vocational schools, including Special Needs Education. Founded in 1998, GTP offers collaborative global learning to over 16.000 students in 35 **countries**, in the following six languages: English, French, Spanish, German, Dutch and Arabic. GTP Learning Circles are offered twice a year, including themes based on the Millennium Development Goals.

We will present several GTP projects from current school year where students of different ages cooperated in on-line activities.
